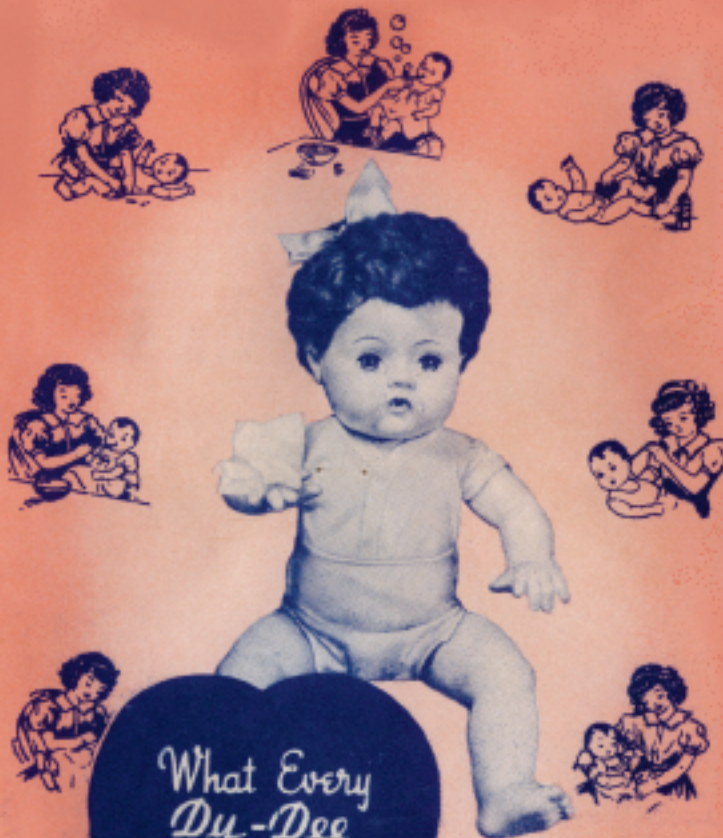

# What Your Almost Human Dy-Dee Baby Can Do



## CRIES FOR HER BOTTLE

All little mothers who own a DY-DEE Doll will be thrilled by another of DY-DEE's accomplishments. . . . Place the "Pacifier" into her mouth, press her tummy gently and you will hear DY-DEE cry for her bottle. . . . Just like a real baby!

## DRINKING FROM BOTTLE, SPOON OR STRAW

DY-DEE is the *only* doll that can drink her bottle sitting up or lying down. Press DY-DEE's tummy gently two or three times, and give her the bottle. After she drinks a little, take the bottle away. DY-DEE can also drink from her clear plastic straw or spoon which come with every DY-DEE.

## DIAPERING

DY-DEE's diapers may need two or three changes after each feeding, and her little mother should be ever watchful for her baby's comfort . . . so be ready to change her diapers whenever necessary. The outlet valve is so arranged that the liquid DY-DEE drinks passes out gradually, a drop at a time. No danger of wetting your own clothes while playing with DY-DEE.



## BATHING

When you bathe your baby, hold her head above the water, although water will not hurt her head. You may use pure soap and plenty of water. Although Dy-Dee has movable arms, legs and head, her body may safely be submerged in water. Her air-tight joints will not permit the water to enter her body.



## CLEANING EARS WITH Q-TIPS

Your new Dy-Dee Doll has adorable soft flexible ears. So we suggest that you use a Q-Tip and gently clean her dainty ears at least once a day. Use soap and water and clean Dy-Dee's ears very thoroughly. Then dry and powder.



## BLOWING BUBBLES

You can have lots of fun making DY-DEE blow soap bubbles. It is so simple! Just dip the bubble pipe bowl in soapy suds, place the nipples stem in DY-DEE'S mouth. Now press DY-DEE'S tummy gently and slowly. My, what beautiful soap bubbles DY-DEE blows!

## EYES OPEN

When DY-DEE is in your arms and her eyes are open you may turn her head to your right. . . . then lay her down in bed and she will stay wide awake and ready for a playful romp. Remember . . . you must never twist DY-DEE's head too far sideways, because that would hurt her.

## EYES CLOSED

You know babies sometimes sleep in their mother's arms, and sometimes lie awake in bed. Well, DY-DEE does this too. Here's how: When your baby is lying down with her eyes closed, turn her head a little to your right side. Now take her in your arms . . . she will go right on sleeping.

## POWDERING

After her bath, powder DY-DEE's little body—all over—especially her neck, arm and leg joints. She will feel very comfortable when you have done it. Now she is clean and fresh and ready for a jolly romp.
